Mode

The tournament will be carried out as age-group-tournament for singles and teams (separate for boys and girls). To an age-group belong all kids that are born between 1st January and 31st December of the particular age-group.

Eligibility to participate

Singles

Every girl and every boy born in 1996 or later, who is of the according age-group (1st January – 31st December), is eligible to participate.

(e.g. Rainer Zufall, born 04/04/1996 -> age-group "boys 1996" / "JE 1996")

(e.g. Melanie Muster, born 24/12/1999 -> age-group "girls 1999" / "ME 1999")

Indices

Every player is allowed only to start in one (= in his) age-group.

Boys and girls are playing in different groups.

Participants do not have to be member of a club!

Team

Girls and accordingly boys can be registered in the entry form as a team, if they play officially in the same club or visit the same school (cut-off date 1st July 2012).

Players without a partner from their own club or school, who want to play in a team, can be registered as team-player without partner. The direction of the tournament will find a partner by lot.

Indices

Every player is allowed to participate, but only in one team (consisting of two players). To play as a team it is necessary that both players be part of the same age-group (1996/97, 1998/99, 2000/01, 2002+younger).

(e.g. Rainer Zufall 1996 + Max Muster 1997 = age-group 1996/97)

(e.g. Martin Zufall 2002 + Christian Muster 2005 = age-group 2002+younger)

Participants do not have to be member of a club!

Regulations

ITTF-Regulations apply to this tournament and accordingly to DTTB- and WTTV-regulations, except from the time-out rule.

Matches are played without time-out!!

Racket controls

There are racket controls. The tests are carried out with approved test equipment, usually before the game.

Rackets, which are not corresponded with the ITTF-rules, may not be used in a game. The player has the unique chance to change the racket.

In reasonable suspicions, the head referee can control the racket post game. If there is a positive finding post game (single and double) the game would be count for lost.

Team

Age-groups:

- 01 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1996/97
- 02 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1998/99
- 03 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2000/01
- 04 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2002 and younger

Mode

Modified Corbillon-System (Team-System). A team consists of two players. Teams with one boy and one girl are not possible to register. The tournament is played in KO-system, singles and doubles are played in best-of-five mode.

Order of the games

A 1 vs B 2, A 2 vs B 1, double, A 1 vs B 1, A 2 vs B 2

Indices

The team-matches are won if one team reaches 3 victories (3:0/3:1/3:2).

Decisive for the team-competition is the notified order of the players in the entry form, which is to be made according to player's skills. It is not possible to change the order during the competition. False statements automatically lead to disqualification.

The supporting documents (official player's list of club or certification of the school) has to be sent to Borussia Düsseldorf until 27/08/2012 if you want to apply a team. If the supporting documents don't arrive in time both players will automatically get a partner by lot.

Players without a partner from their own club or school, who want to play in a team, can be registered as team-player without partner. The direction of the tournament will find a partner by lot.

Every player is allowed to play in only one team. Sole exception: Lucky-Loser-Regulation. The tournament - direction reserves the right to allocate a Lucky-Loser - first-round-loser - of the same age-group to the player who did not get a partner by lot.

Singles

Age-groups:

- 05 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1996
- 06 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1997
- 07 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1998
- 08 Boys and girls of the age-groups 1999
- 09 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2000
- 10 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2001
- 11 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2002
- 12 Boys and girls of the age-groups 2003+younger (see NRW-Talent-Cup)

Mode

The preliminary round is carried out in groups (with 4 players, if necessary with 3 players). The games are played in best-of-five mode. For the final result of a group the number of victories is the decisive factor. As two players have the same number of victories the next decisive factor are the comparison of sets, followed by the direct comparison (victories, sets, balls).



The first and the second of a group proceed to the main draw, which is played as KO-system. The third and the fourth of a group have the chance to play the consolation-round at mini-tables (see below).

Indices

Please specify the performance niveau of players who are listed in national/county rankings in the entry form. Example: No. 3 of national (junior) list

Generally nobody is entitled for a seeding.

Consolation-round

For third and fourth of groups in single-competition

Singles

All participants, that finish the preliminary round on 3rd or 4th place, have the chance to take part in the consolation-round played on mini-tables. In every age-group we are looking for the champion. The consolation-round will start ca. 30 minutes after the preliminary round of the particular age-group is finished.

Mode

KO-system. It will be played one set until 15. The serve changes after to played points (we reserve the right to change the mode).

NRW-Talent-Cup

only for age-group 2003 and younger

Mode

1. Table tennis - competition (girls singles / boys singles)
2. Condition - competition consisting of six disciplines (sprint, standing long jump, throwing the heavy ball, pitching a ball to a goal, slalom-dribbling, sidesteps).
(Changes of the disciplines and of the number of disciplines are possible)

Appraisal of results

The places of each of the two competitions (table tennis / condition - competition) will be assessed with points (1 point for the 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place a.s.o.).

The overall result of NRW-Talent-Cup is made up from the valuation of table tennis and of the condition – competition at a ration of 1:1. Winner will be the boy/girl with the fewest points.

Indices

The winners of the NRW-Talent-Cup will be awarded (best four girls and best four boys) as well as the winners of the table tennis – competition.

Application

Supporting documents

The following **supporting documents** must necessarily **be attached** to the entry form:

Single Registration (one participant):

a copy of the ID-card

Multi Registration (clubs/two or more participants):

an official player's list of club (copy)

Multi Registration (school/two or more participants):

a certification of the school (original) and copy of the ID-card for all players

The according documents can be added as a copy to the entry form except for the certification of the school (original!). Send it enclosed to the online-application or alternatively by E-Mail, facsimile or post to Borussia Düsseldorf.

If the according documents are not presented the registration is not valid. False statements automatically lead to disqualification.

The supporting documents (official player's list of club or certification of the school) has to be sent to Borussia Düsseldorf until 27/08/2012 if you want to apply a team. If the supporting documents don't arrive in time both players will automatically get a partner by lot.

Changes

Changes of application due to disease can only be accepted until the deadline (28th July 2012).

Late application

For organisational reasons we can **only accept late application until deadline**.

Refund

If you will sign off a participant before deadline we have to calculate a administrative charge of € 10,00 for each player.

There is no right of refund of the entry fee for players after the deadline and who did not line up.



Confirmation of participation

Please note that only the incoming of the invoice amount counts as final confirmation of participation after all data (application and supporting documents) is on hand.

Starting documents

The attendant named in the application will receive all starting documents (identification numbers, information) at the Leichtathletikhalle (venue) before start on Friday, 24/08/2012. You will get important information by e-mail about two weeks prior of the event.

Liability

The **organiser is not liable** for lost objects. Furthermore the organiser is not liable for accidents.

Acceptation

All participants and accordingly coaches or attendants automatically agree with all details of the tournament advertisement by sign up for andro Kids Open.

Attendant

We assume that an attendant of every club or school **attends** the whole tournament. The organiser cannot take on the obligatory supervision!

Clothing/material

Participants have to wear sneakers with bright soles! Sportswear is recommended. The jersey must not be white.

Medical care

Medical care by a **doctor** and accordingly a **first aid – team** is guaranteed.

Jury

If it should be necessary to make modifications during the tournament, decisions are as a basic principle made by the organisation-committee.

School release (for participants living in Germany)

Participants can, according to “§43 Abs. 3 des Schulgesetzes (SchulG) für das Nordrhein-Westfalen (NRW)”, be released from school by their parents if they have an important reason. The andro Kids Open are one of the outstanding events in Germany and were in the last few years from schools - not just in NRW - accepted as an “important reason”.
